The Bristol Redevelopment and Housing Authority previously applied to be part of Cohort #1 of HUD's **Moving to Work (MTW) Program**, and we were recently notified that we have been selected to proceed in the process of being designated an MTW agency.

***Moving to Work (MTW)** is a demonstration program for public housing agencies (PHAs) that provides them the opportunity to design and test innovative, locally designed strategies that use Federal dollars more efficiently, help residents find employment and become self-sufficient, and increase housing choices for low-income families. MTW allows PHAs exemptions from many existing public housing and voucher rules and provides funding flexibility with how they use their Federal funds. PHAs in the MTW demonstration have pioneered a number of innovative policy interventions that have been proven to be successful at the local level, and subsequently rolled out to the rest of the country's PHAs. Currently, there are 39 MTW PHAs nationwide and HUD plans to expand the program to an additional 100 PHAs by 2022. PHAs being considered for Cohorts 1 and 2 have been notified of their status and are preparing program designs and plans.*

This is an exciting opportunity, and we look forward to hearing comments and suggestions from our clients and community partners as we develop our MTW Plan.
